Soil Restoration



As a group we come together to bring healing to the land. One of our recent projects involved a sheet mulching Permacult at the Atascadero home of Dr. Sobyl Bunis. Mulch provides a home for beneficial soil microbial life, which is needed to support plants. Additional plants were added to the thriving food forest as well. Healthy soil and healthy plants create a regenerative food system that does not require fertilizers or pesticides! Our Global Family Garden located at City Farm on Calle Joaquin in San Luis Obispo

Community Outreach Branch Mill

We connect with and help our community. One of our on-going locations for food forest creation and good fun times is Branch Mill Organic Farm owned and operated by Ruth Maddocks. Members of our group help Ruth with clean up days prior to her events such as her Earth Day Fair and the Blooming Biodiversity Tour. We have helped Ruth clean, plant and cook for these events and then we get to enjoy the food and music. These events keep us connected and give us opportunities to know each other more deeply.



Greywater Installation



This is one of the ways the Permaculture group provides solutions to the drought. The plumbing from your washing machine can be removed from the sewer line and sent out into your yard where water can be used on your garden. Don't have a garden? We help install those too. A greywater system allows you to get more than one use from the same water. You get clean clothes and grow your own food at the same time. Permaculture Team member, Josh Carmichael of Carmichael Environmental is our resident expert.
